

Bellingham Sister Cities Peace Grant

The *Bellingham Sister Cities Peace Grant* is funded by the Bellingham Sister Cities Association. The objective of this grant award is to improve and expand existing relationships between Bellingham and its seven Sister Cities: Cheongju, Korea; Nakhodka, Russia; Port Stephens, Australia; Punta Arenas, Chile; Tateyama, Japan; Tsetserleg, Mongolia; and Vaasa, Finland.

The *Peace Grant* exchange funding program supports Bellingham-Sister City partnerships by providing funding for up to \$1,000 to outbound exchanges for local U.S. citizens. The Bellingham Sister Cities Association is a community based organization providing opportunities for citizens of Whatcom County to develop relationships and build a sense of community with our sister cities around the world. Our mission is to seek to achieve international understanding, cultural sensitivities and encourage trade and tourism. This is accomplished through cultural exchanges, educational programs and community events. The *Peace Grant* was created to help facilitate this mission.
